**Here are a few Kids For Wish Kids Activity Ideas to help you get started!**

**Paper Chain Competition/ Spirit Chain** - Each grade level competes to make the longest paper chain. Each grade is assigned a different color chain. Links are sold for a set donation.

**Penny War** - Grades compete against other grades to collect the most pennies. Pennies are “positive points” and students are encouraged to put “silver coins” in other jars as “negative points.”

**Make-A-Wish Money Week** - Students donate change each day of the week (Monday - pennies; Tuesday - nickels; Wednesday - dimes; Thursday - quarters; Friday - dollars).

**Dance Marathon** - Reserve your school’s gymnasium and ask a local DJ to donate their services. Have students obtain pledges from relatives and friends. Give each hour a theme, run dance contests, and give prizes to best dancer, best costume, etc. Set a time limit and dance the night away!

**Sell Candy-Grams** - For a set donation, kids write messages to friends and teachers to be delivered during the day. Each message has a piece of candy attached. Great around holidays!

**Plan a Talent Show** - Sell tickets in the community and school for a talent show held at your school. Students and/or teachers perform their greatest talents, such as singing, dancing, magic tricks, baton twirling, etc.

**Duct-Tape Your Principal to the Wall** – Sell strips of duct tape and then have a duct-taping ceremony.

**Car Coin Competition** - Have community members bring their show cars. Put donation cans on each car and the car who collects the most money wins a prize.

**Bachelor/Bachelorette Auction** – Ask students to volunteer to be “auctioned” for a day to the highest bidder. Ask local businesses to donate prizes such as dinner certificates, movie passes, flowers, etc.

**“Superstar for Wishes”** – Students purchase pre-cut stars and write their wishes on them to be hung in the hallway of your school
